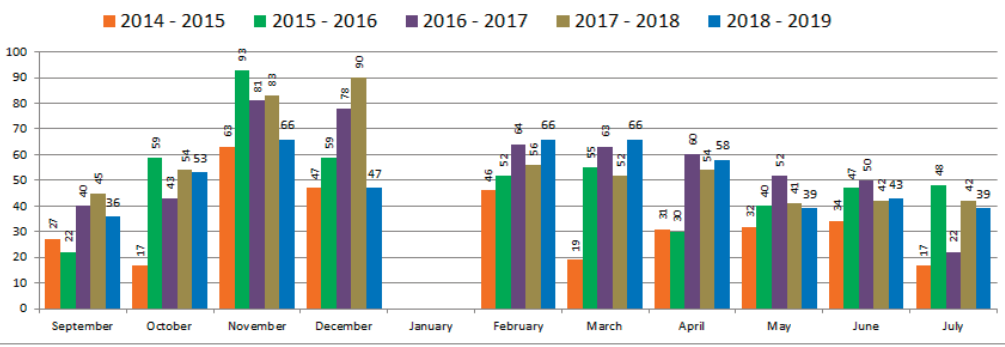

There will be an invoice sent out via email or post to renew your membership for 2019 – 2020 Season.

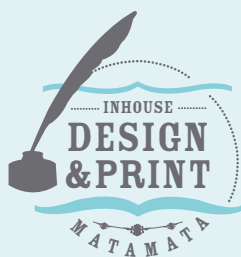
