At just five years old Conrad Dalton also weighed in a pretty good effort! He is pictured with his 1.96kg snapper.

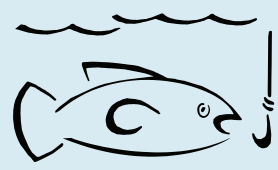


He might not have caught anything but three year old Beauden Dalton was quite happy to show one of his favourites of the weekend too!
