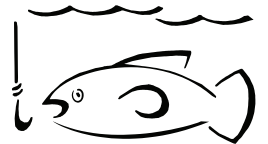

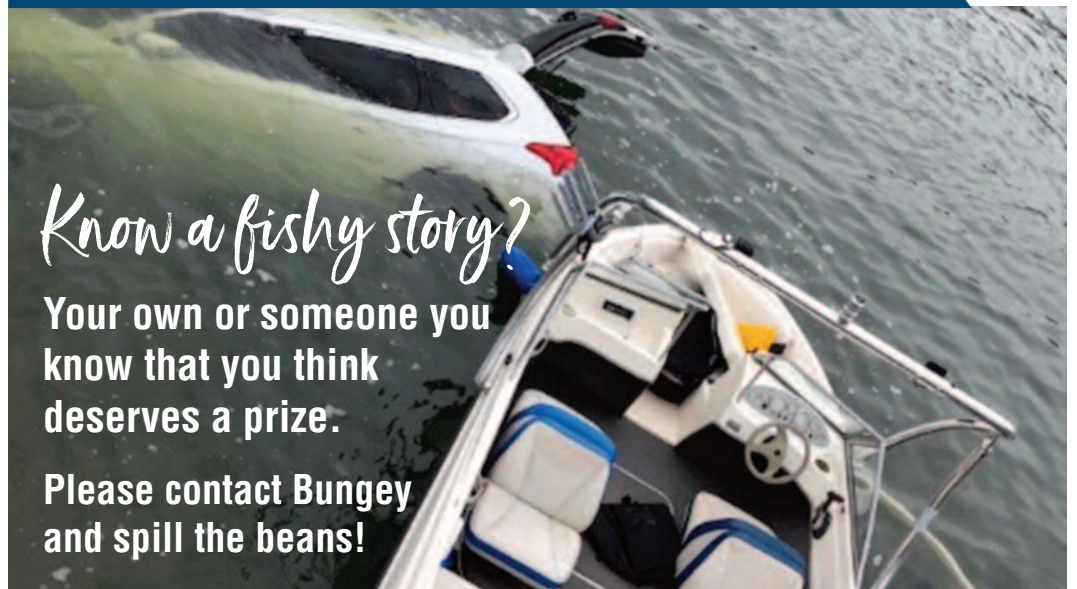

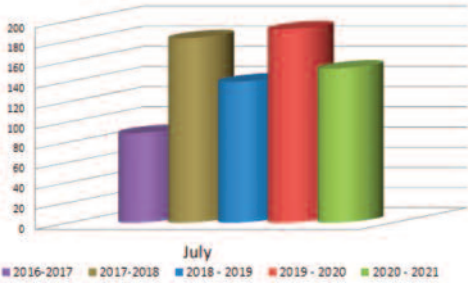

Number of Fish Caught



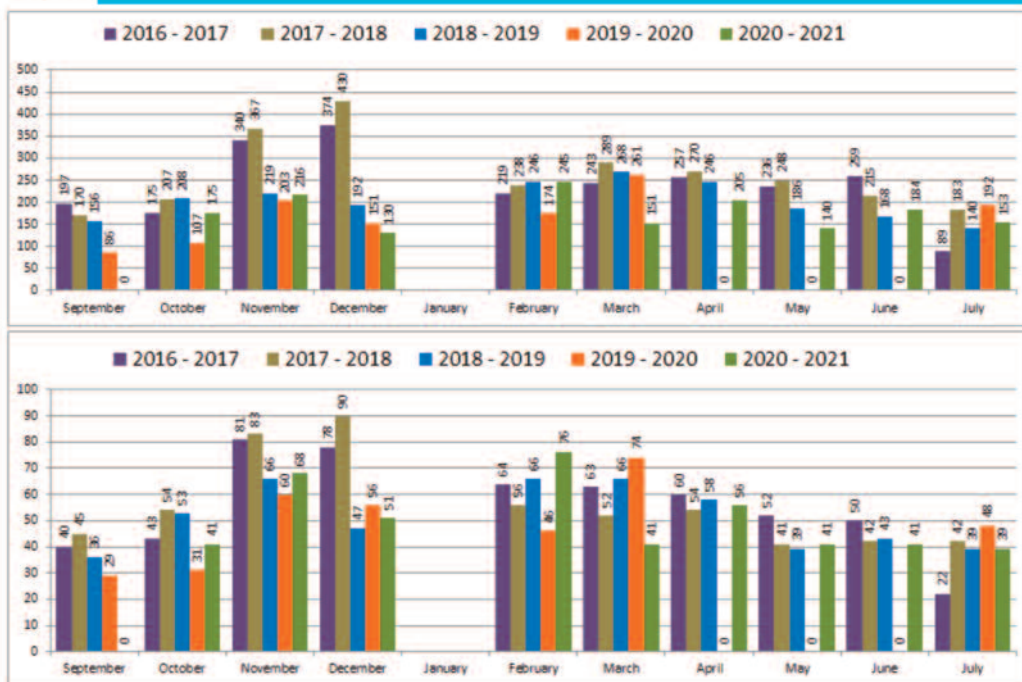
Number of Members weigh in fish
