Recently at our AGM there were three rule changes to be aware of:

- **1. FISHING BOUNDARIES** for this current 25/26 Fishing Season the Boundaries have BEEN REMOVED.
- **2. DRONE FISHING** must be used with only (2) two hooks per rod or handline per fisherman, NO Long lines. NO FISH POINTS FOR ANY FISH

CAUGHT BY A DRONE. There will be a category in selected competitions for any fish caught with the help of a drone.

3. ELECTRIC REELS – may be used if you have a physical disability or only in deep water when fishing for deepwater species i.e. Blue Nose, Hapuka, Gemfish and Bass.

We will trial drone fishing for several months, the first being this **September competition** – there will be a prize for the heaviest fish caught by a drone. Please specify at weigh in if you have caught your fish this way. This will be reviewed by the committee at a later date – this was a suggestion forwarded to the committee and we have decided to give it a go.

Keep an eye out on our website and social media for other plans that we have for our competitions coming up.

Also, if you know of anyone looking to join the club please encourage them to register via our website or get in touch with a committee member.

Hope everyone can get out for our first competition for the season and make it a great start. Happy fishing and be safe.

DECISIONS FROM THE AGM

- 17. **FISHING BOUNDARIES** for this current Fishing Season 2025 2026 the Boundaries have been removed this will be discussed again at the August 2026 AGM. The club has a 155km radius from the Matamata Post Office as the fishing boundary as per map in the back of this book. To fish outside this boundary the angler will give his her intention in the form of a text or email to the Weigh Master or Fishing Club email address on the first day of the competition. Every angler will be able to fish outside the boundary twice (2) times per fishing season. If no fish are caught outside the boundary this will still count as a boundary crossing. Any fish caught outside of the boundary with more than 2 crossings will have NO points rewarded to them.
- 18. **DRONE FISHING** must be used with only (2) two hooks per rod or handline per fisherman, NO Long lines.

- NO FISH POINTS FOR ANY FISH CAUGHT BY A DRONE. There will be a category in selected competitions for any fish caught with the help of a drone. Please advise the Weigh Master when weighing these fish in.
- 19. **ELECTRIC REELS** may be used if you have a physical disability or only in deep water when fishing for deepwater species i.e. Blue Nose, Hapuka, Gemfish and Bass.

We are trialling several competitions using a drone to take out a line from the shore with only two hooks attached – any fish caught will NOT GET ANY FISH POINTS – they will go towards the prize for the heaviest drone fish caught only.

Non-members fishing competition is planned for October – non-members will be able to fish this by paying a small entry fee – more information to follow.

We have one committee member that has stood down this year.

Many thanks to Natalie Clothier for her two-year service to the committee.

Welcome back Eileen Ward to the committee and three newcomers, Grant and Sue Dixon and John Price, looking forward to their input for the season ahead.


